- Educating the whole child (Mrs. Klein's guidance lessons, intervention groups, support from administration, and individual counseling)
- Building positive, lasting relationships

Academics

Honors/Advanced classes - Mr. Toler and Mrs. Klein looked at entrance exams, ISTEP scores, grades, and teacher recommendations to properly place students.

- Students Must Complete All Assignments
- Homework - All students have homework
- All students should be using their google suite which includes calendar, email, classroom, etc.

Unique Programs: Panther Reader and EXCEL

- Panther Reader
 - Structured Reading time each morning from 8:00 – 8:30
 - Incentivized and individualized
 - Reading levels monitored weekly via ReadTheory
- EXCEL Block
 - “Enriched homeroom” 11:16 - 12:06
 - Students in good academic standing choose enrichment groups each 9 weeks
 - Structured intervention time provided for students in need of extra help

What to do if your student needs help academically...

- **Tutoring 3:30-4:30 Monday, Wednesday, Thursday**

This can be requested by the teacher, parent, or student. Staff-parent confirmation must occur.

- Parental Support at home: work on math facts, reading every night, communication with teachers, accessing Harmony for grade and assignment updates.
- Placed in intervention class during “excel” period.

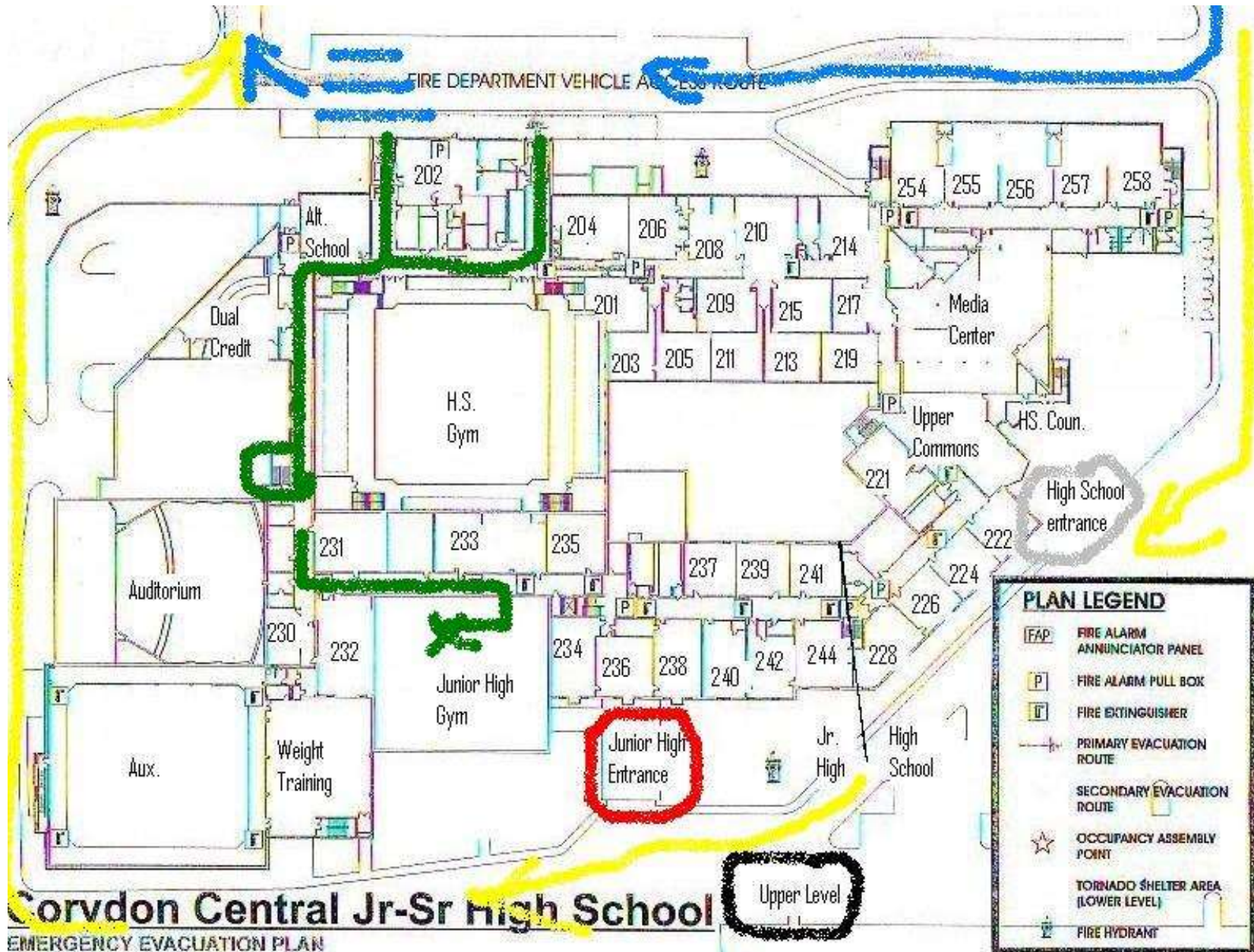
Daily School Schedule

Upper Level

Harmony

- Harmony is our school database system where your students grades, discipline, attendance, and medical issues are cataloged.
- Parents: Please make sure you fill out all registration forms ASAP.
- Students will not receive their chromebooks until all forms are filled out.
- Once you setup your account (tonight) you will have access to your students information.

ATTENDANCE

There are three types of absences...

- excused (doctor's note)
- parent documented
- unexcused

Please call when your child is absent and send
in doctor's note when seen by doctor

Parents are sent a message if the school is not
contacted

Excused Absences

- ❑ **Proper Documentation Required**
- ❑ Verified illness by a doctor
- ❑ Medical and dental appointment
- ❑ Death in the family
- ❑ Exclusion because of exposure to a contagious disease
- ❑ Court appointment or Probation
- ❑ Religious Holiday
- ❑ **Does not count against student attendance**

Parent Documented Excuse

- ❑ **Pre-arranged absences or illness**
- ❑ Call the office anytime, press 8 for attendance
- ❑ Note with student, we will message you of absence.
- ❑ Letter sent home at (8) eight days warning parent that the limit is approaching, 10 day limit for the school year.
- ❑ (11) eleven days is a violation of the policy
- ❑ THESE ABSENCES STILL COUNT AGAINST A STUDENT'S ATTENDANCE

Unexcused absence

- ❑ **Parent has not contacted school, or the Principal determines absence unexcused**
- ❑ Most common occurrence is the call or note was forgotten.
- ❑ Parent will receive a school message to inform of the absence. **Confirmation of parent is still required.**
- ❑ Potential truancy if we don't have verification of where student is

Handbook

- Please familiarize yourself with the handbook.

Discipline

- CCJHS Discipline Philosophy: Students are becoming young adults and we want to treat them as such. Emphasis on educating students to take responsibility for their own behavior. “Exercise self-discipline in a healthy social and emotional environment”
- Progressive Discipline: a consequence of an action will be based off of previous actions.
- Teachers can assign lunch detentions
- Administration will give lunch detentions, office detentions, suspensions, etc.
- Discipline record is available for parents in Harmony

Dress Code

Objective of dress code: “Dress for the career you want”

Restricted Items:

- Holes in pants that expose the skin well above the knee - mid-thigh or above
- Shorts and skirts need to be mid thigh (running shorts)
- Excessively tight clothing (yoga pants)
- Tops that do not cover the shoulders/underarm areas
- Low cut tops that expose the chest
- Midriff Tops
- Mesh or see through clothing that expose the skin
- Sagging pants
- Hats, berets, caps, sunglasses, and any other head coverings (religious exceptions will be approved by the principal).
- Visible undergarments
- Piercing that is unsafe to the student or other students

*** We give students opportunities to correct any dress code issue

Devices

No cell phone use during school hours (8:00 - 3:20)

- Phones can be taken away by staff and returned at the end of the day or when parent picks phone up from main office.
- Please do not text or call your students cell phone during school hours. If there is an emergency, call the main office.
- Students are allowed to use the main office phone if they need to contact parent/guardian.

Chromebooks

- Please take care of these chromebooks as they are an expensive device. Chromebooks are school property and are on loan to you!
- Technology agreement sheet must be signed before chromebooks are distributed.
- Students should not carry in their backpacks
- Ensure students comes to school everyday with a CHARGED chromebook.
- Please monitor what your child is doing on their chromebook when at home... especially emails!

Safety and Security

Student safety is #1 priority

- Resource Officer: Officer Bye and Officer Duley
- Security Cameras in hallways and around campus to ensure safety
- Doors are always locked
- Teachers and admin in hallways monitoring students and guests

Bus Behavior

- Expectations for bus behavior are students remain seated during bus ride and are quiet during transport
- Bus referrals result in conference with principal and further discipline may be assigned based on transgression
- As with all areas of our school - student safety is #1 priority.
- In the case of repeated bus issues, a student may be suspended from the bus for a period.
